

BP Card – Terms and conditions

Farmlands Co-operative Society Limited ("Farmlands") has an agreement with BP Oil New Zealand Limited ("BP"), under which Farmlands may make BP Cards available to its shareholders on certain terms and conditions ("the BP Conditions of Use").

Farmlands has agreed to make a BP Card available to you. By signing or using your BP Card, you agree to comply with and be bound by the following Terms and Conditions.

1. You agree to comply with and be bound by the BP Conditions of Use, which may be amended from time to time. Under those terms and conditions, BP has limited and excluded various liabilities. You agree that those limitations and exclusions shall also apply to you for the benefit of Farmlands and BP.
2. You must pay for all purchases made using your BP Card whether or not they are authorised by you. You must also pay all Government rates, taxes or charges which now are or which in the future may be charged upon purchases made using your BP Card, whether or not you are primarily liable for the impost or charge. You authorise Farmlands to debit all purchases made using your BP Card, all such rates, taxes or charges, all transaction fees and all fuel card fees to your Farmlands Card account.
3. You agree that the Farmlands Card Terms and Conditions apply to your BP Card in addition to these Terms and Conditions.
4. Your BP Card remains the property of BP. Farmlands or BP may cancel your BP Card at any time without notice. You must immediately return your BP Card to Farmlands if it is cancelled or if requested by Farmlands.

5. You agree that Farmlands is not responsible if BP or a merchant refuses to accept your BP Card at any time, for BP or a merchant's inability to supply any goods or services you require at any particular time or place.
6. To the extent permitted by law, Farmlands excludes all liability it may have in relation to:
 - a. all goods and services purchased using your BP Card;
 - b. the actions or inactions of BP and merchants;
 - c. any unauthorised use of your BP Card; and
 - d. anything else related to your BP Card..

The Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 overrides the provisions of these Terms and Conditions and you are entitled to the benefit of the relevant guarantees set out in the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993.

7. You are responsible for the safe custody of your BP Card and any PIN issued for your BP Card. If your Card or your PIN is lost, stolen or likely to be misused you must immediately notify Farmlands by calling 0800 200 600 followed by written confirmation that must be received by Farmlands within 7 days..
8. Farmlands may vary these Terms and Conditions at any time and will give you notice in writing of any variation.
