All boats must have lifejackets for each person on board, flares and a VHF radio or cellphone. Coastguard channel is VHF channel 61.

NB: MPI regulations apply and you will be fishing by competition rules (copy attached).

Numbers are limited to 400 competitors (first in, first served).

Entry is intended for Farmlands shareholders, customers and sponsors.

Prizes will be awarded for the following categories – Heaviest Fish, Best Condition and Brown Trout.

If the competition is cancelled, join us for lucky draws and a light meal at Farmlands Taupo on Friday 2nd February at 5.30pm.

LAKE TAUPO FISHING COMPETITION 2018



1. Entry fees must be paid before the competition starts and only paid up competitors are allowed on the boats, with a minimum of two persons per boat. NO REFUNDS will be given after the close off date of Tuesday 30th January 2018.
2. Fishing commences no earlier than 6.00am on the day of the competition. All boats must be back in Taupo by 6.00pm.
3. All anglers must have a current Lake Taupo Fishing Licence and adhere to all rules and conditions stated on the licence.
4. There will be no event briefing. All entrants will be expected to participate in accordance with these rules and in the spirit of the event.
5. In the event of a tie, the first fish over the scales will take the prize. The weigh shed is open from 4.00pm at the Farmlands Taupo car park.
6. It is the angler's responsibility to ensure the fish are presented and weighed.
7. Boats that have genuinely broken down may, with specific authorisation from the organisers, put anglers and fish on another boat and must still reach the channel by weigh-in time.
8. Each boat must carry minimum safety equipment and it is essential that all boats carry either VHF radio or cellphone.
9. The organisers have the right to refuse any entry and the right to inspect any fish or boats.
10. The competition is held in the spirit of amateur fishing and fair competition. If in the opinion of the organising committee, competitors have breached the spirit of the competition then the committee reserves the right to exclude the competitor(s). The committee's decision will be final.
11. Prizegiving starts at 7.00pm on Friday 2nd February 2018 at Farmlands Taupo, 101 Tauhara Road.
12. All prize winning anglers must attend prizegiving to receive their prize. Any prize winning anglers not in attendance will forfeit their prize and it will be awarded to the next placing. Spot prizes not collected quickly will be redrawn.
13. All entrants, boat owners and spectators participate at their own risk. The organisers, promoters, sponsors or any other party connected with the event accept absolutely no responsibility in any respect for personal injury, loss or damage to property, regardless of the cause.
14. In the unlikely event of cancellation, join us for lucky draws and a light meal at the Farmlands Taupo store at 5.30pm on Friday 2nd February 2018. No entry fees will be refunded.
15. Fishing on the lake must be from a boat only. NO RIVER FISHING.
16. No undersized fish.
