THE RULES

FARMLANDS GISBORNE FISHING COMPETITION 2021

1. Entry fees must be paid before the competition starts and only paid up competitors are allowed on the boats, with a minimum of two persons per boat. NO REFUNDS will be given after the close off date of Thursday 15th April 2021.
2. Fishing commences no earlier than 6.00am on the day of the competition. All boats must be back at the weigh station by 4.30pm for fish to be eligible for competition. Weigh in starts from 9.00am.
3. In the event of a tie, the first fish over the scales will take the prize.
4. Event briefing will take place on Thursday 15th April at 6.00pm in the Shark Bar at Tatapouri Sports Fishing Club.
5. It is the fisherman's responsibility to ensure the fish are presented and weighed.
6. Boats that have genuinely broken down may, with specific authorisation from the organisers, be towed back to shore with authorisation. Fish may still be eligible for competition.
7. Each boat must carry minimum safety equipment and it is essential that all boats carry either VHF radio or cellphone.
8. The organisers have the right to refuse any entry and the right to inspect any fish or boats.
9. The competition is held in the spirit of amateur fishing and fair competition.
10. Prizegiving starts at 6.00pm on Friday 16th April at Tatapouri Sports Fishing Club in the Shark Bar.
11. All prize winning anglers must attend prizegiving to receive their prize. Any prize winning anglers not in attendance will forfeit their prize and it will be awarded to the next placing. Spot prizes not collected quickly will be redrawn.
12. All entrants, boat owners and spectators participate at their own risk. The organisers, promoters, sponsors or any other party connected with the event accept absolutely no responsibility in any respect for personal injury, loss or damage to property, regardless of the cause.
13. In the unlikely event of cancellation, join us for lucky draws at the Tatapouri Sports Fishing Club on Friday 16th April at 6.00pm. No entry fees will be refunded.
14. Fishing must be from a boat only.
15. Only 1 fish per angler per species will be weighed. 1 fish = 1 prize and only 1 prize per angler per species.
